1. Adjust PH as needed. No more than 2# per dose (Retest the next day and adjust if needed)
2. Add Chlorine Tabs to Chlorinator.

6. Clean water line.
7. Clean the pool bottom
1st connect the vacuum head to the hose and pole, put it to pool. Feed the hose into the water from the head end until reaching the open end. Connect to the skimmer. Close off the other skimmer and bottom drain (if pool has one). Vacuum pool much like vacuuming a carpet.
8. Clean all baskets and sweeper net, along with sweeper hose wall screen.
9. Check filter pressure

Always turn off pump before turning the filter valve handle.
Pump off/ valve to backwash, pump on / till backwash clear.
Pump off/ valve to rinse, pump on/ rinse 15 seconds.
Pump off/ valve to filter, pump on / the filter should read what the clean filter pressure above reads.
